<p>Responses to the call</p>	<p>8 responses Hertsmonceux (UK) Kanpur (India) Tel-Aviv (Israël) La Plata (Argentina) Rome (Italy) Santiago de Cuba (Cuba) Pecny (Czech Republic) Zhuhai (China)</p> <p>Jérôme presents a summary of the proposals (site, location, host agency, colocations) The proposals need to be evaluated now according to criteria associated to a grading scheme and weighting factors. Objective: IDS Feedback on September 30th, 2022</p> <p>An online meeting will be held on September 15 to set up the short ranked list based on the mandatory criteria, before the Groupe Mission DORIS at CNES on September 22 where it will be presented. Doppler collision tests will be asked for the selected sites.</p> <p>Action Jérôme, Frank, Guilhem: complete the evaluation criteria and define the next steps</p>
<p>Future of GOP analysis center</p>	<p>GOP – need of grant project supporting the operation and evolution of the IDS AC A proposal of grant project to Czech ministry of Education has been submitted in July, including a letter of intent signed by Frank G. Lemoine (bilateral cooperation GOP - GSC).</p>

<p>Elections in fall</p>	<p>Positions to renew for 2023-2026: Analysis Coordination: Hugues Capdeville (2 terms) & Petr Stepank (1 term) Member at large: Claudio Abbondanza (1 term)</p> <p>Action Laurent and Frank: set up the nominating committee</p> <p>NB: Ernst appointed as IAG rep. for 2019-2022 (TBC) Action Laurent: Ask IAG EC (or Zuheir) to appoint a rep. for 2023-2026</p>

<p>DORIS special issue</p>	<p>9 papers in the special issue: 5 accepted, 4 in review submissions close on July 1st (agreement with the editor) 100 pages required for a special issue. Possible extension until end of September.</p> <p>Note that DTRF2020 and JTRF2020, not yet published, are expected for comparison studies.</p> <p>However, good chances for 3 more papers by end of September. Ernst expects the titles.</p> <p>Action Frank and Guilhem: discuss with authors what is reasonably possible</p>
